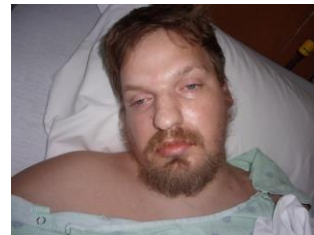

Operation Drive Sober Results in 11 Arrests 1976 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff Richard R. Schmidt ordered an aggressive Operating While Intoxicated (OWI- drugs and/or alcohol) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of intoxicated drivers. This weekend's Operation Drive Sober initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through today at 6:00 a.m., resulted in the arrest of eleven drunken drivers. The average PBT test results was .12.

Three repeat offenders were arrested: Cory Kotz, age 25, of Waukesha was arrested for OWI - 2nd. Andrew Kaczmarek, age 49, of Oak Creek, and Joshua Gelhaar, age 36, of Milwaukee, were both arrested for OWI – 4th.

First-time offenders taken into custody were: Sean Keen, age 24, of West Allis, Carvelia Ray, age 24, of Sheboygan, Molly Johnson, age 23, of Menomonee Falls, Adrian Vasquez, age 29, of Milwaukee, Juliana Scallon, age 25, of Milwaukee, Shawn Kosik, age 42, of Milwaukee, Francisco Orozco-Lopez, age 23, of Milwaukee, and Brandon Ewing, age 25, of Milwaukee.
