REVENUE ESTIMATE PROVES WISCONSIN RECOVERY

Madison – State Senator Paul Farrow (R-Pewaukee) released the following statement in response to the latest revenue estimate by the Wisconsin Department of Revenue (DOR):

“Today’s revenue estimate proves once again that Wisconsin is headed in the right direction and the Wisconsin Recovery is underway. More work needs to be done to continue this promising trend, but all Wisconsin taxpayers should feel confident in the new estimates.

“Predictably Democrats will look to make the current estimates into a political negative. I hope the hardworking residents of Wisconsin will remember that these Madison liberals are the same politicians who attempted to tax their way out of their own shortfall by imposing a \$1.2 billion tax increase on the citizens of Wisconsin. By contrast, under Governor Walker and Legislative Republicans, \$650 million in tax cuts have been provided and a \$3.6 billion deficit has been eliminated.

“The reforms and tax cuts are working and any statement that says otherwise comes from those that are rooting against a Wisconsin Recovery and choose to ignore our recent past. State Government has eliminated waste, provided relief to property taxpayers, and cut income taxes for all. Providing that kind of relief and putting money in the pockets of Wisconsin’s hardworking citizens will continue to help grow our economy and build confidence in our consumers.

“In only three years, Wisconsin has turned things around. According the Bureau of Labor Statistics we are #3 in job growth in the Midwest and we are in the midst of the lowest unemployment rate in more than 5 years. We have learned from mistakes others have made in our past and are looking toward a brighter future.”
