## Rep. Thiesfeldt Stands for Healthcare Freedom

### *President Biden's latest actions are unconstitutional*

In response to the President's address yesterday stating he will mandate a vaccination policy upon the American people and businesses, State Representative Jeremy Thiesfeldt released this statement:

**“ ‘...our patience is wearing thin.’ Those were the words of the President of the United States yesterday afternoon, when he again knowingly violated his oath of office to ‘preserve, protect, and defend the Constitution of the United States’. In using the word ‘our’, Joe Biden is siding with what he suddenly perceives as a constitutional right of one group of Americans over the clear constitutional rights of another group, and he is willing to invoke the powers of the federal government to enforce it. His vaccination order is clearly unconstitutional and Joe Biden knows it -- he has publicly said as much. Federal agency (OSHA) powers do not eclipse the Constitution.**

***My patience is wearing thin* for a president who is willing to exert federal control over the most personal of decisions -- healthcare.**

***My patience is wearing thin* for a president and a governor who weaponize government agencies for political gain.**

***My patience is wearing thin* for a president who is willing to violate the constitutional rights of Americans to distract from his falling poll numbers due to his other international and domestic failures.**

***My patience is wearing thin* for a president and a governor who invoke illegal, precedent-setting executive powers knowing it will likely take months for the courts to catch up.**

**Government cannot invade the clear, core constitutional freedoms it is obligated to protect. This is the proverbial ‘fox guarding the henhouse’. Court action must commence immediately, and I call on all Americans to reject Joe Biden's illegal power grab. If allowed to stand, I see little in the way of the growing powers of the occupant of the office of the President.”**
