Deputies Arrest 11 in Operation Drive Sober OWI-5th and OWI-2nd causing injury in rollover crash 1985 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

OWI-2nd rollover crash

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff Richard R. Schmidt continues an aggressive Operating While Intoxicated (OWI- drugs and/or alcohol) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of intoxicated drivers. This past weekend's Operation Drive Sober initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through 6:00 a.m. Monday, resulted in the arrest of eleven drunken drivers. The average PBT test results were .15.

Two repeat-offenders were arrested: Gary Brown, age 54, of Milwaukee, and Devon Moore, age 27, of West Allis. Nine people were taken into custody for OWI-1st: Angela Medina, age 36, of Waukesha; Mariah Strong, age 20, of Glendale; and Milwaukee residents: Brennan Roche, age 21; Israel Yang, age 20; Christopher Glisper, age 28; Charlie Castrejon-Medina, age 26; Vakia Bland, age 23; Mysty Johnson, age 21; and Terrence Hughes, age 32.

On Sunday, at 2:45 a.m., squads were dispatched to a vehicle in a ditch at I-41/US-45 northbound near Good Hope Road. The driver complained of minor arm pain, and showed signs of being intoxicated. He refused to perform standardized field sobriety tests or give a breath sample for the PBT. Deputies arrested Gary A. Brown, age 54, of Milwaukee, for OWI-5th. His prior convictions were in March 1993, April 1993, June 2004 and January 2005. Brown also refused a blood draw at the hospital and an affidavit and search warrant were submitted to the on-call judge for approval.

If convicted of this fifth offense, Brown faces up to ten years in prison.

On Sunday, at 12:30 a.m., deputies responded to a rollover crash on I-43 westbound at Loomis Road. The Mini Cooper had landed on its roof, and two male subjects were seen running from the vehicle. A deputy found the men walking on S. 44th Street and was assisted in detaining them by a Greenfield police officer. Both men had abrasions and cuts and were treated by Greenfield Fire Department emergency personnel.

The men admitted to having been in the crash. The driver showed signs of intoxication and also had several corner cuts of a methamphetamine in his pocket. Devon Moore, age 27, of West Allis, was arrested for OWI-2nd offense/Causing Injury. The passenger, Andrew Moore, age 21, of Milwaukee, was arrested for a Resisting/Obstructing warrant. Devon Moore's previous OWI was in October of 2014. He had a .02 BAC restriction on his license and faces up to 6 years in prison, if convicted.
