Representative Rob Brooks receives 2018 Wisconsin Realtors Association’s “Chairman’s Citation” Award

Madison, WI—This week, the Wisconsin Realtors Association, at their annual meeting, presented Representative Rob Brooks (R-Saukville) with their “Chairman’s Citation” Award for his commitment to private property rights, ensuring that every Wisconsinite has access to safe, quality housing, and land use regulation reform.

The Wisconsin Realtors Association established the award in 1998 to recognize individuals who have made exceptional contributions to the association or real estate industry.

“As a realtor for 30 years, receiving one of the industry’s most prestigious awards, is truly an honor. During my tenure in the legislature, I have worked with the Wisconsin Realtors Association to protect private property rights, streamline land use regulations, and ensure that Wisconsinites have access to safe, affordable, and quality housing,” Representative Rob Brooks said.

This session, Representative Rob Brooks authored Assembly Bill 770, the “Housing Affordability and Development Act,” which sought to make housing more cost-effective for Wisconsinites by reducing expenditures and streamlining the processes associated with building new homes and developing residential subdivisions. Additionally, he authored Assembly Bill 771, the “Affordable Rental Housing Act,” which contained myriad provisions making it easier for landlords to provide Wisconsin residents with safe, quality, and affordable housing.

“I am eager to continue working with the Wisconsin Realtors Association to identify best practices for improving access to housing,” Representative Brooks stated.
