**Governor Evers Releases Partisan Ploy**

**Madison** – Rep. Dan Knodl (R-Germantown) issued the following statement upon Governor Evers’ release of his partisan document to save face after vetoing AB 191, which would repeal the burdensome and antiquated personal property tax in Wisconsin. Assembly lead author of AB 191 Rep. Knodl reacts:

“Governor Evers made a massive mistake in July when he vetoed AB 191. Now, after receiving the backlash of his actions from the small business community he and some of his democrat colleagues come out with this partisan work around. The governor had his shot at signing AB 191, which had support from both sides of the isle, instead he came up with excuses. This governor doesn’t care about repealing this tax and giving Wisconsinites much needed relief, he cares about partisan attacks and this only exemplifies that.”

“This is extremely upsetting considering we satisfied as many of the governor’s demands we could. AB 191 gained overwhelming support from our state’s small business community and received a bipartisan vote on the Assembly floor. The governor listed that AB 191 would expand tax breaks to out-of-state manufacturers. This remark is uninformed, as we amended the bill to satisfy that specific concern. Again, proving this is just another attack aimed at Republicans.”
