TOFT RECEIVES TOP RATING FROM NRA

First-time candidate Steve Toft received an AQ rating while Ron Kind only rated C

Osseo, WI – The National Rifle Association honored Steve Toft’s commitment to protecting the 2nd Amendment with its top rating for a first-time candidate AQ.
