## Statement on Passage of AJR 80/ SJR 63

MILWAUKEE— Jacob Malinowski, communications director at the Fair Elections Project, issued the following statement in response to the party-line votes on AJR 80 / SJR 63 regarding redistricting this Tuesday:

“Despite an outcry from Wisconsinites against this duplicitous pro-gerrymandering resolution, Speaker Vos, Leader LeMahieu, and their caucuses unanimously voted in favor of rigging Wisconsin maps forever.

“AJR 80 / SJR 63 use faulty premises to ensure incumbents keep their positions, bake in gerrymandering for generations to come, and show us that Assembly and Senate Republicans prioritize political power over democracy and representative government.”
