Deputies Arrest 10 in Operation Drive Sober OWI-5th and OWI-1st crash 1993 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff Richard R. Schmidt continues an aggressive Operating While Intoxicated (OWI- drugs and/or alcohol) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of intoxicated drivers. This past weekend's Operation Drive Sober initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through 6:00 a.m. Monday, resulted in the arrest of ten drunken drivers. The average PBT test results were .15.

Two repeat offenders were arrested: Douglas Slock II, age 45, of Greendale, for OWI-5th and Cory Brunner, age 30, of Milwaukee, for OWI-2nd.

Eight first-time offenders were taken into custody: Anthony Rutzinski, age 26, of West Allis; Glen Johnson, age 41 of Hollywood, Florida; Jeffrey Harris, age 38, of Attica, Michigan; Kamil Czachor, age 27, of Island Lake, Illinois; Frank Parker, age 55 of New Orleans; and Milwaukee residents: Derambo Patterson, age 32; Corey Nash, age 44; and Kontrell Givens, age 32.

OWI-5th

On Sunday, September 30, at 1:30 a.m., a deputy stopped a speeding vehicle that was not keeping to its lane and struck a curb near Maplewood Court. The man got out of his vehicle, approached the deputy and asked, "Why are you following me?!" The deputy noted signs of impairment, but the man refused to do the field sobriety tests.

Douglas Slock II, age 45, of Greendale was arrested for OWI-5th, a felony punishable by up to six years in prison. His license had been revoked and his prior convictions occurred in December 1998, December 2004, October 2010, and January 2018.

This morning at about 2:20 a.m., deputies responded to a crash on I-43 southbound near North Avenue. A semi-truck cab had crashed into the median, taking out sections of the concrete wall and coming to rest straddling the wall. Lanes needed to be closed in both directions on the freeway while the scene was cleared.

Frank Parker, age 55, of New Orleans, tested a .20 on a PBT and was taken into custody for OWI-1st, and cited for Failure to Control Vehicle and Open Intoxicants in a Motor Vehicle.
