Sen. Cowles Receives Friend of Towns Award

Senator Rob Cowles of the 2nd Senate District was awarded the 2017-18 Friend of the Towns Award for his efforts on behalf of town interests.

He also co-authored legislation to close the “dark store” tax loophole, a bill that would prevent a tax shift to homeowners.
