ICYMI: Wisconsin State Senate Named Battleground Chamber

State Senate Chamber poised to flip from Republican to Democratic control

MADISON, Wis. – Yesterday, the [University of Virginia Center for Politics](#) named the Wisconsin State Senate among the battleground chambers nationwide where Democrats are poised to flip party control.

Sabato's Crystal Ball noted that Wisconsin State Senate Democrats are particularly close to flipping control of the chamber, saying:

*In six chambers Democrats could gain control by netting just two or fewer seats: the tied Connecticut and Minnesota senates, the Colorado and Maine senates, where Rs lead by one, and the Arizona Senate (now 17 R, 13 D) and **the Wisconsin Senate (18 R, 15 D)**.
(emphasis added)*

The State Senate Democratic Committee has already successfully worked with candidates to flip two seats in 2018, beginning with January's victory for Patty Schachtner in Wisconsin's 10th Senate District and winning a second flip in June with the election of Caleb Frostman in the 1st Senate District.
