Sporting Heritage Package Introduced

Madison – Representative Treig E. Pronschinske (R-Mondovi) along with other elected state officials introduced the Sporting Freedom package on Wednesday October 13th. Also in attendance were activist group Hunter Nation and their spokesperson, rock legend, Ted Nugent.

“With thousands of hunters in our state, it is important that we listen to their concerns and continue to safeguard this rich heritage we have in Wisconsin. As an active outdoorsman, I value our traditions and take them very seriously. This package is about so much more though, it’s about preserving the hunt, demanding transparency, and protecting our rights for our children’s future and the generations after them.” stated Rep. Pronschinske.

“These issues are extremely important now more than ever,” continued Rep. Pronschinske. “I am looking forward to these bills coming to my committee and moving them forward for Governor Evers to sign.”

The package of bills includes constitutional carry, establishing a DNR habitat plan, issuing dog licenses online, streamlining the turkey hunt, simplifying hunter safety field day requirements, publishing a public land report, reducing the number of different kinds of hunting licenses and other transparency and simplification proposals.
