DAY 13: SPENDING MORE MONEY TO PROVIDE LESS HEALTHCARE

Since taking office, Governor Walker has rejected billions of dollars of federal funding to expand Medicaid to tens of thousands of Wisconsinites. Walker's failure has reduced affordable healthcare access, cost taxpayers hundreds of millions, and increased the cost of insurance. The nonpartisan Legislative Fiscal Bureau determined that fully expanding Medicaid would cover 79,000 more Wisconsinites and would save Wisconsin taxpayers \$203 million over this budget cycle. According to Citizen Action of Wisconsin, this could also reduce premiums on the ACA marketplace by 7 percent. By accepting the Medicaid expansion monies, the state could provide healthcare to more Wisconsinites while saving millions of taxpayer dollars. Instead, Scott Walker is actively sabotaging the healthcare thousands of Wisconsinites depend on by suing to stop the Affordable Care Act. Now that's pretty scary.
