**Rep. Knodl Calls for Resignation and Prosecution of Meagan Wolfe**

**Madison** – Rep. Dan Knodl (R-Germantown) issued the following statement upon the revelations that illegal voting occurred last year in a Racine County nursing home:

“I hold Administrator Meagan Wolfe responsible for this breach of our democracy. The Wisconsin Elections Commission (WEC) enabled this by going rogue and issuing unilateral guidance that weakened important election integrity safeguards. Just last week, an independent audit by the Legislative Audit Bureau found that WEC acted outside the law in issuing this guidance.

“Our democracy is not secure so long as the door remains open to voter fraud. It is especially egregious when it occurs at the expense of our most vulnerable neighbors in long-term care facilities. The evidence points to what we have been warning about all along, and it is time to double down on our efforts to investigate these violations and prevent them from happening again.

“Meagan Wolfe should apologize. Then she should resign. And then the Attorney General should prosecute her to the fullest extent of the law.”
