Rep. Vorpapel Statement on Election Investigations

Madison- State Representative Tyler Vorpapel (R-Plymouth) issued the following statement after the release of information from the Legislative Audit Bureau’s election investigation and the Racine County Sheriff’s investigation over the course of the last week:

“After hearing concerns from voters across the state following the 2020 election, the Legislature initiated an audit through the Legislative Audit Bureau back in February. The results of the audit we received last week are very concerning and show that election law was not followed in multiple instances last year.

“The information we learned yesterday from the Racine County Sheriff’s investigation is equally as concerning. The lack of Special Voting Deputies in nursing homes due to the guidance issued by the Wisconsin Election Commission in contradiction to state election law is unacceptable. It shatters voter trust in those tasked with overseeing statewide elections. Individuals responsible for breaking state law should resign.

“The Legislature recognized these issues and passed a package of election integrity bills earlier this year to fix them. Unfortunately, Governor Evers chose to veto them. We will continue our work in the Legislature to ensure the integrity of our elections, and I call on both Governor Evers and Attorney General Kaul to stop standing in the way.”
