### **HYPOCRISY DEFINED**

*Any investigation must examine not only the leaks but the entire misconduct*

(MILWAUKEE) - State Representative Frederick P. Kessler (D-Milwaukee), said today he is deeply troubled by the extent of the hypocrisy displayed by Attorney General Brad Schimel stemming from the letter he filed with the Wisconsin Supreme Court requesting the Wisconsin Supreme Court appoint a special master to investigate the breach of the secrecy orders in the John Doe case related to *The Guardian* newspaper leaks. The Attorney General now finds a John Doe procedure relevant.

“There were prior leaks in the John Doe case and even an article in the Wall Street Journal, however, the Attorney General did not call for a special master to investigate those leaks. I am in no way endorsing the leaking of confidential court documents, however, this reeks of hypocrisy,” continued Kessler.

“I think it would be a disservice if any investigation does not also look into the entire misconduct that has been brought to light.”
