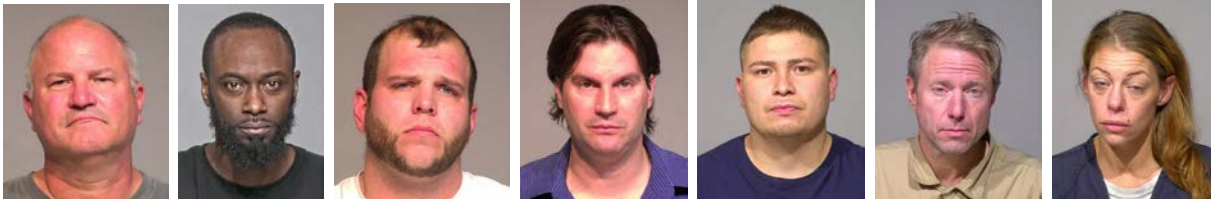

Deputies Arrest 13 in Operation Drive Sober OWI with child in vehicle; OWI crash 2015 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff Richard R. Schmidt continues an aggressive Operating While Intoxicated (OWI- drugs and/or alcohol) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of intoxicated drivers. This past weekend's Operation Drive Sober initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through 6:00 a.m. Monday, resulted in the arrest of 13 drunken drivers. The average PBT test results were .14.

Six repeat-offenders were arrested: Philip Bourbonais, age 55, of Wauwatosa, for OWI-3rd; Ricky Davis, age 37, of Milwaukee, for OWI-3rd; Kristopher Stiefel, age 55, of Mukwonago, for OWI-3rd; Robert Bertling, age 42, of Franklin, for OWI-2nd; Roberto Hernandez, age 29, of West Allis, for OWI-2nd; and Eric Leisten, age 53, of Milwaukee for OWI-1st/pending OWI-2nd.

Seven first-time offenders were cited for OWI-1st : Michael Paczkowski, age 30, of Delavan; Keyon Williams, age 35, of Milwaukee; Regan Andersen, age 31, of New Berlin; Christie Kriederman, age 39, of South Milwaukee; Cadriss Green, age 22, of Milwaukee; Sierra Myers, age 31, of Brookfield; and Daniel Mulroy, age 34, of Milwaukee.

Two of the OWI-1st offenders face additional charges. Christie Kriederman was stopped for unsafe lane deviation on I-94 westbound at the stadium interchange at 2:40 a.m. on Saturday, November 3. A three-year-old child was in the vehicle. Kriederman performed poorly on the field sobriety tests and was arrested for OWI-1st/Drugs with Child Under 16 in Vehicle. The child was turned over to Child Protective Services at 6:25 a.m. to be placed in emergency foster care. Kriederman was also cited for Unsafe Lane Deviation, Imprudent Speed, Seat Belt Violation for Child, and Operating Without a License. If convicted on the OWI charge, she faces up to six months in jail.

On Sunday, November 4, at about 2:50 a.m., deputies responded to a single vehicle crash on I-894 northbound near Beloit Road.
