Senator Janet Bewley Wins Re-Election to the Wisconsin State Senate

Mason, WI - Early this morning, Janet Bewley won re-election to serve another four year term in the Wisconsin State Senate. Senator Bewley defeated Republican challenger James Bolen with 51% of the vote.

“I want to thank everyone who supported me and my campaign over the last several months,” Said Bewley, “When I got into politics, I pledged to run on the issues affecting my constituents , and I’m proud of the race that we ran on those very issues. It is a great honor to be re-elected to the Wisconsin State Senate and I pledge to continue to work for everyone within the 25th Senate District, regardless of their political persuasion.”
