



Dana Wachs calls out Gov. Walker for weak response to Roy Moore sexual misconduct allegations

EAU CLAIRE – Dana Wachs spoke out today regarding Gov. Walker's weak response to allegations of sexual misconduct by Roy Moore, an Alabama candidate for the U.S. Senate:

"I am sickened by the attempts of some Republican leaders to deny or justify this kind of disgusting, criminal behavior. Preying on children is inexcusable. Gov. Walker should denounce it without reservation.

"While I am encouraged that so many survivors of sexual assault are willing to speak out about their experiences, I hope that society will soon acknowledge that it isn't the responsibility of the survivor to call out predators. I also hope our leaders will finally admit and address the reality that women in our communities have faced all their lives — that sexual predators are often excused while girls or women who speak up about the abuse they have experienced are ignored or punished. It has to stop. We are all responsible for building healthy, safe environments.

"There is no place for a sexual abuser in public service."
