Rep. Tittl Named Chair of Mental Health Committee

MANITOWOC – Rep. Paul Tittl (R-Manitowoc) has been named chair of the State Assembly Committee on Mental Health by Speaker Robin Vos.

“I am very pleased to be named chair of the Committee on Mental Health,” Rep. Tittl said. “I thank Speaker Vos for the confidence he has in me.”

During the last legislative session, Rep. Tittl was chair of the Committee on Mental Health Reform. That committee was created to build on the work of the Speaker’s Task Force on Mental Health.

“We accomplished some good things on the Speaker’s Task Force and on the Committee on Mental Health Reform,” Rep. Tittl said.

During the last session, the Assembly passed a number of mental health related reforms. One helped school districts and families by making it easier for kids to access mental health services at school. The governor signed that piece of legislation into law earlier this year.

Rep. Tittl plans to re-introduce several of the other bills early in the next session.

“We will continue to bring forth common sense reforms to help some of the most vulnerable people throughout Wisconsin,” Rep. Tittl said. “I’m excited for the session to start.

The upcoming session begins on January 3rd.
