Representative Petryk: Re-appointed Chair of Committee on Workforce Development

ELEVA – Representative Warren Petryk has been named Chair of the Assembly Committee on Workforce Development for the third consecutive session. During his time chairing the Workforce Development Committee, Wisconsin has added thousands of good-paying jobs and seen record low unemployment rates. Legislation supported by the Workforce Development committee has enabled businesses across Wisconsin to fill in-demand jobs and hire skilled workers.

Representative Petryk made the following statement regarding the announcement of committee chairs:

“It is truly an honor and privilege to have been chosen as the Chairperson of the Assembly Committee on Workforce Development for the upcoming 2019-2020 legislative session. During my time as Chair, our Committee has moved ahead on key legislation which directly benefits hardworking families living in communities throughout Wisconsin.”

Last session, the Committee passed key legislation that expanded youth apprenticeships, created a new program to provide transitional jobs for veterans, promoted competitive integrated employment of persons with a disability, created income tax deductions for apprenticeship programs, and established career and technical education incentive grants for school districts.

The Assembly Committee on Workforce Development consists of the chair and 14 committee members. Representative Petryk was first appointed chair of the committee in 2015.

“I look forward to continuing our work and am committed to finding new ways to bring more jobs to our state by growing our state’s workforce and providing opportunities for workers to gain critical skills.”
