Representative-Elect David Crowley Elected New Milwaukee Delegation Chair

MILWAUKEE, WI – State Representative- Elect David Crowley (D-Milwaukee) made the following statement after being voted unanimously as the next Chair of the Milwaukee Delegation for the 2017-18 legislative session.

“As we prepare for the upcoming biennium in the Wisconsin Legislature, it is important that we become united in our goals as a city and as a county,” said Representative-Elect Crowley. “Under the Governor’s leadership, Wisconsin families have faced both historic cuts to public primary and secondary education and increased costs in childcare and healthcare. With a diminishing middle class due to the continued assault on organized labor, families everywhere are really feeling the pinch.
