Statement on WisDOT Secretary Appointment

Wisconsin Motor Carriers Association President Neal Kedzie issued the following statement on the announcement by Governor-elect Tony Evers of Craig Thompson to serve as Wisconsin Department of Transportation Secretary:

"I extend my sincere best wishes to Craig Thompson on his appointment to lead the Department and hope his skills and knowledge serve him well in this important state agency. I have known Craig for many years and am confident he will meet the many challenges that lay ahead and have been discussed for several years."

"Most notably, a long-term and viable solution to transportation funding that is fair and reasonable, especially to those in the trucking industry who pay nearly 40% of all monies received by the transportation fund. Trucking companies understand the need for safe and reliable roadways, especially in our consumer-driven economy which relies on trucking to move 84 percent of manufactured tonnage in Wisconsin and nearly 70 percent of all goods.
