Judge JoAnne Kloppenburg Endorses Everett Mitchell for Dane County Circuit Court

Madison - Wisconsin Court of Appeals Judge JoAnne Kloppenburg has endorsed attorney Everett Mitchell for Dane County Circuit Court, Branch 4. She joins three of her colleagues on the Court of Appeals – Judges Blanchard, Higginbotham, and Sherman – in endorsing Attorney Mitchell.

“Circuit courts are the front line of our state court system and circuit court judges, every day, hear cases that affect people’s lives, their businesses, our safety and our communities,” Judge Kloppenburg said. “Attorney Mitchell has the background, experience and commitment to fairness to become a fine judge.
