Senator Lazich Applauds the Protection of Free Speech

Madison, Wis. – Today, the Wisconsin State Senate approved Assembly Bill 387 (AB 387), campaign finance reform. Senate President Mary Lazich (R-New Berlin) issued the following statement:

“As a necessity, a healthy democracy must have robust free speech. The approval of AB 387 protects free speech for all Wisconsinites and ensures our campaign finance laws are navigable for the ordinary citizen. AB 387 brings our convoluted and partially legal statutes in line with court rulings.”

“We should not thwart anyone’s efforts to speak freely, whatever their message might be. It is through the free exchange of ideas that freedom and individual liberty is protected and a healthy society prospers. The First Amendment rights of all Wisconsinites are once again unencumbered by outdated laws.”

Senator Lazich represents parts of Milwaukee, Waukesha, Racine, and Walworth counties.
